Follow-up Suggestions for Formation of New Associates

- 1. Inviting those who are exploring the possibility of becoming Associates or friends of the Associates to the monthly meetings.**
- 2. Getting young adults involved in a service project with other Associates or friends.**
- 3. Study of "Pilgrimage to Holy Cross" with Brothers' Constitutions for those already familiar with Holy Cross Spirituality.**
- 4. Complete the initial formation process for new associates using the "Come Follow Me" suggested program.**
- 5. Forming those not familiar with Holy Cross spirituality & the charisms of Holy Cross, using the booklet "Pilgrimage to Holy Cross".**
- 6. Asking those who are not involved in the church to first join an RCIA program in their parish.**
- 7. Note: Joining us would not be beneficial for non-Christians, since Holy Cross spirituality is based on Christ and the call to a Christian vocation.**
